KEY PORT HIGHLIGHTS

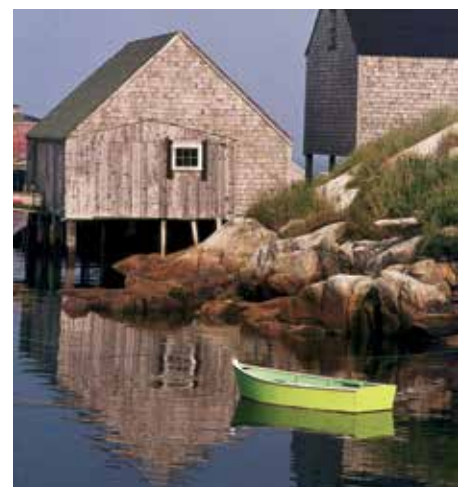

Charlottetown: PEI may be Canada's smallest province but it is big on history and attractions. It is here that the famous Conference of 1864 was held which resulted in the creation of the Canadian confederacy. Learn all about it on a walking tour of Charlottetown, the provincial capital.

Halifax: Here find craggy coastlines, fabled Peggy's Cove and the striking German village of Lunenburg, so meticulously restored it has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Québec City: Holland America Line's #1 rated port for the past few years. A tree-lined 'Champs-Elysees', buttery croissants, the lilt of French, a grand château on the river. 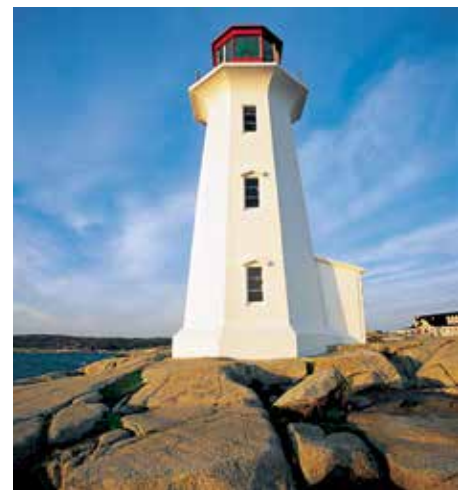
Acadia National Park & Lobster Bake (Bar Harbor, Maine)

A journey along Park Loop Road showcases the spectacular scenery of Maine’s rocky coastline. Continue past Thunder Hole, Otter Cliffs and the Jordan Pond House and, weather permitting, you will head to the 1,530-foot summit of Cadillac Mountain — the highest point on North America’s eastern seaboard. With a 360-degree panoramic view, you will see how glaciers carved through the granite cliffs to form a beautiful landscape. Sit down to a true Downeast lobster bake in a beautiful setting along the coast.
